## GRANT COUNTY QUORUM COURT

The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, September 17, 2018 at the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Members answering rollcall were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tommy Cobb, Tony Carder, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto and Grant Westmoreland.

Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order.

The minutes from the Quorum Court meeting held, August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018, were presented to the Quorum Court for review. A motion to accept said minutes was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Pat O'Bryan. With there being no further discussion or questions: Vote 8 for 0 against. Motion Carried.

The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court and reviewed. With no opposition to the Financial Statement as presented, a motion to accept was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. With there being no further discussion or questions: Vote 8 for 0 against. Motion carried.

Next on the agenda, Judge Pruitt introduced a bid letter from Precision Rescue in the amount of \$32,557.33 for the purchase of a battery operated spreader which is attached to the minutes. The bid was reviewed and discussed. Justice Grant Westmoreland made a motion to approve the bid of \$32,557.33 and authorize Grant County Rescue to purchase the Rescue Equipment, to be paid out of the Ambulance Tax Fund. Justice Tony Carder seconded the motion. With there being no further discussion or questions: Vote 8 for 0 against. Motion carried.

Sales Tax reports were introduced and reviewed.

In Other Business:

Ed Monk will be at the Courthouse on October 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 to discuss active shooter and concealed carry. Justice Jason Rostho explained, he would like to sponsor an ordinance allowing county employees and elected officials to conceal carry on county grounds. He explained, he has discussed the topic with several county officials and that before going further, he believes it would be beneficial for the county to hear from Ed Monk who is an expert in the field and invites the county to come out.

The Conservation District has invited the Quorum Court for dinner on October 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:00.

John Cox, the new grounds keeper from Cox Creek Camp Ground was introduced to the Quorum Court members. Mr. Cox thanked the Quorum Court for all their hard work and asked the Quorum Court to continue to spread the word around Grant County about the Cox Creek improvements and to encourage people to come out and utilize the Camp Grounds.

A Comp Time report for all Grant County employees was prepared by the Clerk's Office was introduced and reviewed.

With there being no further business to conduct. Motion to adjourn.
