The **Financial Statement** was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion, a motion to accept was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 9 for 0 against.


**Ordinance No. 2019 – 08: AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2020; APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATING ACCOUNTS; APPROPRIATING TRANSFERS; AND FOR OTHER COUNTY BUDGET PURPOSES.** Justice Tony Carder said no new personnel were approved for this budget. Big items are Election \$50,000.00, the twenty-seventh (27<sup>th</sup>) pay period \$80,000.00, and possible insurance increase of eleven percent (11%). After no further discussion, a motion was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 9 for 0 against.

**Sales Tax:** Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court with no discussion.

**Other Business:** Judge Randy Pruitt informed the Court that the MEMS Annual Report was in and that MEMS does a good job of reporting. Justice Grant Westmoreland said we are very appreciative of their reporting. Justice Tony Carder said on the Comp. Time report that there was one (1) person over 120 hours. Judge Randy Pruitt said he would follow up. Judge Randy Pruitt advised that the land at Cox Creek was 10.1 acres and that he was looking into grant money being available for that as well as playground equipment. **Motion to Adjourn.**
