Solid Waste Contract: RESOLUTION # 2020 – 02 A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL AGREEMENT FOR WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICE BETWEEN WASTE MANAGEMENT OF ARKANSAS, INC. AND GRANT COUNTY. Judge Randy Pruitt explained this is a proposal to extend with minimal increase for County. Currently 5,000 – 5,500 tons per year. He explained we have had no increase to our local customers in years. Compared with contract pricing from Stanley & Sons, not close. A motion was made to accept by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 9 for 0 against.

**Sales Tax:** Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court. Treasurer Tim Stuckey explained that next couple of months will tell how Covid – 19 may change numbers.
