The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, December 21, 2020 in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Brody Channell, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Bobby Pierce, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

The **Minutes** from the Quorum Court Meeting held, **November 16, 2020** was presented to the Quorum Court for review. With no further discussion, a motion to accept was made by Justice Grant Westmoreland and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 8 for 0 against.


The **Financial Statement** was presented to the Quorum Court. Justice Bobby Pierce questioned \$5000.00 for State Trooper Fee. Judge Randy Pruitt explained that we seldom use these monies, but it was originally budgeted to assist with radios. With no further discussion, a motion to accept was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Mark Allen. Vote 8 for 0 against.

Ordinance No. 2020 – 11: “AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATING ACCOUNTS; APPROPRIATING TRANSFERS; AND FOR OTHER COUNTY BUDGET PURPOSES.” Justice Mike Nevens gave an overview of the changes to the budget as compared to last year’s budget. He talked about employee pay increases and newly approved staff additions. Judge Randy Pruitt explained that Grant County was allotted \$627,000.00 from the CARES ACT and we have been approved for all but \$1400.00 of it. With no further discussion a motion was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto to approve. Vote 8 for 0 against.


Sales Tax: Sales Tax Report was presented to the Quorum Court with no discussion.
