Grant County Quorum Court Special Meeting April 5, 2021



The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, April 5, 2021 in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

NEW AMBULANCE BUILDING BIDS: ORDINANCE NO. 2021-03: Judge Randy Pruitt discussed bids for the new Ambulance Building. The lowest bid presented was from Robert Shepherd for \$344,000.00. This represents an increase of about \$110,000.00 over what was originally approved by the Quorum Court. Judge Pruitt explained that due to the tremendous cost increase in materials due to COVID 19, we need to do a new Ordinance if we want to continue with the project. Justice Grant Westmoreland commented that if MEM's builds their own building, our current rent will probably go to somewhere around \$2,500.00 - \$3,000.00 a month. Judge Pruitt responded that we have the money and that our bid package is only good for fifteen (15) days. With no further discussion a motion to approve was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Mark Allen. Vote 8 for 0 against.
