The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, July 19, 2021, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Lisa-Michele Haber, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

MINUTES: The Minutes from the June 21, 2021, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 9 for 0 against.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Tony Carder. Vote 9 for 0 against.

DISTRICT COURT AUTOMATION FUNDS: Judge Randy Pruitt explained that the District Court was purchasing additional cameras and a monitor. These items shall be paid for by the City of Sheridan, but this requires approval from the Quorum Court. With no further discussion, a motion was made to approve by Justice Grant Westmoreland and seconded by Justice Jim Easley. Vote 9 for 0 against.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 – 08 AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 2015 – 02: Judge Pruitt explained that new legislation had increased the bid limit from \$20,000.00 to \$35,000.00 and would allow us to stay within the State guidelines. With no further discussion a motion to suspend second (2nd) reading was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 9 for 0 against. After second (2nd) reading "Title Only", a motion to suspend third (3rd) reading was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 9 for 0 against. After third (3rd) reading "Title Only", Judge Randy Pruitt asked if there was any more discussion. With no further discussion, a motion to adopt was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Pat O'Bryan. Vote 9 for 0 Against.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-09 AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT AN ADDENDUM # 2021-01 TO THE GRANT COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICY 2019; BY CREATING A CATASTROPHIC LEAVE PROGRAM AND SETTING FORTH PROCEDURES FOR THE DONATION AND APPLICATION THEREOF: Judge Randy Pruitt explained that this had previously been discussed and was changed to add one (1) Quorum Court Member to the Leave Committee. He then gave a brief overview of the policy. With no further discussion a motion to suspend the second (2nd) reading was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 9 for 0 Against. After second (2nd) reading "Title Only", a motion to suspend third (3rd) reading was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Tony Carder. Vote 9 For 0 Against. After third (3rd) reading "Title Only" Judge Pruitt asked if there was any more discussion. With no further discussion a motion to adopt was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 9 For 0 Against.

RESOLUTION 2021 – 03: Judge Pruitt announced this Resolution had been pulled and tabled until another meeting.


SALES TAX: Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.
