Grant County Quorum Court August 16, 2021

COURTS AN 8: 23

The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, July 19, 2021, in the Grant County Court house at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

MINUTES: The Minutes from the July 19, 2021, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 8 for 0 against.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 8 for 0 against.

GRANT COUNTY MINIMUM ROAD SPECIFICATION AND REGULATIONS: Judge Randy Pruitt explained that the Quorum Court members each had a packet detailing the new road specifications as put forth by the Grant County Road Committee. He highlighted the point that number 14 requires a two (2) year bond or Irrevocable Letter of Credit that developers would need to have before the County can take over repairs and maintenance of a road. Contractors will be responsible for all roads to meet the criteria in the road specifications. Judge Pruitt asked for the Members to look over the Road Committee's recommendations and he would have an Ordinance prepared for the next scheduled Quorum Court meeting.

RESOLUTION 2021 – 03 GRANT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (HMP): Judge Randy Pruitt talked about the fact that we include all cities, municipalities and school districts in our plan to include all within our jurisdiction. With no further discussion, a motion to adopt was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Mark Allen. Vote 8 for 0 Against.

SALES TAX: Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

OTHER BUSINESS: Judge Randy Pruitt informed the Court that the Belfast Fire Protection District had delivered their five (5) proposed Board Members to be voted on by the registered voters in their District. He will set a public meeting and election for 6:00 PM on the day of the next scheduled Quorum Court Meeting. After the public meeting, the Quorum Court Members will need to confirm the electees for the Fire District.
