The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, October 18, 2021, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Lisa-Michele Haber, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

MINUTES: The Minutes from the September 20, 2021, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 9 for 0 against.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 9 for 0 against.

GRANT COUNTY CONSERVATION OFFICE REPORT – MELISSA SHAW / JOHN MITCHELL: Judge Randy Pruitt introduced Melissa Shaw to report on the Grant County Conservation Office. Ms. Shaw explained that the Conservation Office had turned in two hundred seventy-one (271) beaver tails through their eradication program that is funded in part by Grant County. She expressed their gratitude for the support they receive from the County. Cody Harrington (District Conservationist for Grant, Saline, and Hot Spring Counties) informed the Court that there was an \$141,000.00 obligation to Grant County for conservation and \$60,000.00 had been spent. Remaining funds will roll from year to year

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 – 10 – TO ADOPT NEW MINIMUM ROAD SPECIFICATIONS AND REGULATIONS FOR ROADS TO BE ADDED INTO THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM AS A COUNTY ROAD, REPEALING GRANT COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 98 - 02: (SECOND 2ND READING) Judge Randy Pruitt said after discussions and being in newspaper he has had no negative input and asked if any Court Members had been approached. No one else had had any complaints or questions. A motion to suspend the third (3rd) reading was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 9 for 0 against. After third (3rd) reading Judge Randy Pruitt asked if there was any discussion? With no further discussion a motion to approve was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Danny Bone. Vote 9 for 0 against.

SALES TAX: The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

OTHER BUSINESS: Judge Randy Pruitt informed the Court that we were completing our Annual Legislative Audit. He informed the Court that we would have a **Supplemental Finding** in the 2020 Audit because he did not report the 2019 Audit Report to the Quorum Court. He also explained that in the 2019 Audit we had **Supplemental Findings** related to Capital Outlay in one (1) Sheriff Department car being misvalued and one (1) wrecked vehicle that was never on inventory. He explained that whenever the 2020 Audit was complete he would give a complete report at the following Quorum Court Meeting
