The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, March 21, 2022, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering **roll call** were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Pat O’Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

MINUTES: The Minutes from the February 22, 2022, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 6 for 0 against.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Grant Westmoreland and seconded by Justice Pat O’Bryan. Vote 6 for 0 against.

CLINT HARPER: Judge Randy Pruitt introduced Mr. Clint Harper who spoke to the Quorum Court and submitted attorney costs from an accident involving a county vehicle for \$105,000.00 that he is requesting the Court to reimburse him for. After discussion, Mr. Harper was informed that the Quorum court would take his request under consideration and would get back with him at a later date.

DISTRICT COURT AUTOMATION FUNDS: Judge Randy Pruitt informed the Court that Judge Gibson had presented a bill for approval of the purchase of furniture for the District Court. Judge Pruitt explained that these would be paid by the city and just needed approval from the Quorum Court and the City Council. A motion to approve was made by Justice Pat O’Bryan and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 6 for 0 against.

SALES TAX: The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

OTHER BUSINESS: No further business.
