The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, August 15, 2022, in the Grant County District Court room at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

MINUTES: The Minutes from the July 18, 2022, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Danny Bone. Vote 8 for 0 against.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 8 for 0 against

LIBRARY BOARD: Judge Randy Pruitt informed the Court that he had performed the "swearing in" ceremony for the newest Library Board members. The members are Carolyn Ashcraft, John Cole, Margaret Dobson, Gary Kelly, and Karla Koon. The Quorum Court must approve the Board Members. A motion to approve was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Jim Easley. Vote 8 for 0 against.

SALES TAX: The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

OTHER BUSINESS: Jacob Palmer candidate for the Sheridan School Board Zone 2 Position 7 spoke to the Quorum Court about his desire to serve. Judge Randy Pruitt reported on the County Annex Building project. He stated that the Building Committee had discussions about uses for the building. After discussions, Judge Pruitt expressed his desire to bring in people from the community other than just Quorum Court members to decide what to do with the facility. Judge Pruitt asked the Court for input on the old fairground property. The County purchased the property in 1953 for \$1350.00. He explained that he gets frequent calls regarding animals running loose in the county and would like to look at the feasibility of placing an animal shelter in the location of the current animal pens.
