The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, September 19, 2022, in the Grant County District Courtroom at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering **roll call** were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

**MINUTES:** The Minutes from the August 15, 2022, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 7 for 0 against.

**FINANCIAL STATEMENT:** The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 7 for 0 against

**MICHAEL MICHAEL – GRANT COUNTY FAIR BOARD:** Judge Randy Pruitt introduced Michael Michael President of Grant County Fair Board. Mr. Michael spoke to the Court about the “new” Fairgrounds located on 167 North and the struggles that the Fair Board has had in moving to the new location. He informed that by next year the Grant County Fair and Rodeo should all be located at the new location. He thanked the Court for their continued support of the Fair Association and hoped that our relationship could continue. He asked if the County would assist in purchasing a cover for the new arena being built. Justice Mike Nevens asked if he had a cost estimate for the arena cover. Mr. Michael informed that the cost to cover the arena is \$1.3 million unless the price has increased since they received pricing and requested that they have a cost share with the County. After discussion, Mr. Michael agreed to put together a financial plan and review and submit to the Court for consideration

**DISTRICT COURT AUTOMATION FUND:** Jude Randy Pruitt explained this is for a computer that was purchased and approved by Judge Gibson. With no discussion a motion to approve was made by Justice Grant Westmoreland and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 7 for 0 against.

**SALES TAX:** The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2022-12: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2021-14, THE 2022 ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS.** Appropriation Ordinance 2022-12 was read to the Quorum Court. After no discussion, a motion to approve was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Mark Allen. Vote 7 for 0 against.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** Judge Randy Pruitt informed the Court on the status of our “chip seal” project. Should start on Wednesday and take about three (3) weeks to one (1) month. Justice Tony Carder asked about the “License Reader” project. Judge Randy Pruitt will check on status and report at next meeting.
