The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, October 17, 2022, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

**MINUTES:** The minutes from the September 19, 2022 Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 8 for 0 against.

**FINANCIAL STATEMENT:** The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Pat O'Bryan. Vote 8 for 0 against.

**SCOTT WINSTON:** Dr. Scott Winston spoke to the Quorum Court regarding the new arena that he is building in Grant County and the anticipated benefits that it will bring. He also expressed concerns as a citizen that the Grant County Fair Association has asked the Quorum Court to assist in funding a cover for another arena that would be in direct competition with his project. His concern is setting precedence for any 5013c to come and ask the Court to fund their projects.

**SALES TAX:** The Sales Tax Report was presented to the Quorum Court.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** Justice Grant Westmoreland spoke of concerns from citizens about personal vehicles for Emergency Responders traveling through town at a high rate of speed. Judge Randy Pruitt responded that lights and sirens on a vehicle are asking for permission to have a right of way, but do not give one solely because of lights. He will contact all Emergency Response supervisors and speak to them regarding concerns.
