The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, November 21, 2022, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. with Judge Randy Pruitt presiding. Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Pat O'Bryan, Jason Roshto, and Grant Westmoreland.

**MINUTES:** The Minutes from the October 17, 2022, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Grant Westmoreland. Vote 8 for 0 against.

**FINANCIAL STATEMENT:** The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 8 for 0 against

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-13: AN ORDINANCE LEVYING THE MILLAGE RATES FOR ALL COUNTY TAXES:** After first (1<sup>st</sup>) reading, a motion was made to suspend second (2<sup>nd</sup>) reading by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Mark Allen. Vote 8 for 0 against. After second (2<sup>nd</sup>) reading **"Title Only"**, a motion to suspend third (3<sup>rd</sup>) reading was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 8 for 0 against. After third (3<sup>rd</sup>) reading **"Title Only"**, a motion to adopt was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Mark Allen. Judge Randy Pruitt asked if there is any more discussion. With no further discussion, vote 8 for 0 against

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03: ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE NATURAL RESOURCES DIVISION UNPAVED ROAD GRANT:** Judge Randy Pruitt discussed the purpose of the grant. He explained that the request had not been submitted to the Road Committee, but it would use our labor as our percentage of "In Kind" commitment. Justice Mike Nevens asked if we could chip seal later. With no further discussion a motion to approve was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Tony Carder. Vote 8 for 0 against.

**SALES TAX:** The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

**DISTRICT COURT AUTOMATION FUND:** Judge Randy Pruitt explained that the District Court was purchasing new computer equipment for \$4,132.06 and needed the Quorum Court approval. The purchase will be paid by the City, but Court approval is required. With no further discussion a motion to approve was made by Justice Tony Carder and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 8 for 0 against.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** Justice Grant Westmoreland asked about the status of the county computer system. Prosecuting Attorney Teresa Howell addressed and read a prepared statement regarding the computer issues.
