The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, June 19, 2023, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. Grant County Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, Paul Drake, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Jason Roshto, and Scott Wells.

MINUTES: The Minutes from the May 15, 2023, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 8 for 0 against. (Motion passed)

Financial Statement: The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 8 for 0 against. (Motion Passed)

SHERIFF PETE ROBERTS: Grant County Sheriff David (Pete) Roberts gave an update on the current status of the Sheriff's Office. He informed the court that his Officer's had performed 1625 hours of training so far this year. The Department has been approved for a **Highway Traffic Grant** in the amount of \$113,175.00 for installation of computers in patrol vehicles. Prattsville would like to have a part-time deputy and has agreed to pay for the service.

ORDINANCE 2023 - 08: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2022-14, THE 2023 ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS: Judge Randy Pruitt explained this Ordinance is for repair work on the Courthouse Building and grounds. \$150,000.00 for repair of the Bell Tower, and \$100,000.00 to repair the building foundation. With no further discussion a motion to adopt was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Danny Bone. Vote 8 for 0 against. (Adopted)

AUDIT REPORT: Judge Randy Pruitt discussed the last audit for the County. He mailed a copy to all Justices for their review. Judge Pruitt informed this is the cleanest audit the County has had in seven (7) years.

SALES TAX: The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.
