The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, July 17, 2023, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. Grant County Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Paul Drake, Jim Easley, Mike Nevens, Jason Roshto, Scott Wells, and Grant Westmoreland.

**MINUTES:** The Minutes from the June 19, 2023, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. Vote 8 for 0 against. (Motion passed)

**Financial Statement:** The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Grant Westmoreland and seconded by Justice Mike Nevens. Vote 8 for 0 against. (Motion Passed)

**SALES TAX:** The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** Judge Randy Pruitt discussed the Solid Waste meeting and the discussion about possibly going cash less. Treasurer Tim Stuckey reported that we have about 1/2 dozen bad checks per year that are usually small amounts. Judge Pruitt remarked that we are making progress at the new Solid Waste site needing the water main connection tap and that the saddle and valve are on back order. Judge Pruitt reported that bids will open on July 26, 2023, for work on the Bell Tower. He also reported they will be letting bids for the framing, sheet rock, and HVAC for the basement of the Annex Building soon. He reported a scheduled phone meeting about the Solar project on July 18, 2023, with a request to look at the Ordinance that is required at the scheduled August Quorum Court Meeting.
