The Grant County Quorum Court met on Monday, April 15, 2024, in the Grant County Courthouse at 7:00 p.m. Grant County Judge Randy Pruitt called the meeting to order. Members answering roll call were Mark Allen, Danny Bone, Tony Carder, David Damron, Paul Drake, Mike Nevens, Jason Roshto, and Scott Wells.

MINUTES: The Minutes from the March 11, 2024, Quorum Court Meeting were presented. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. **Vote 8 for 0 against.** (Motion passed)

Financial Statement: The Financial Statement was presented to the Quorum Court. Treasurer Tim Stuckey commented that Circuit Court fees were down. With no further discussion a motion to accept was made by Justice Jason Roshto and seconded by Justice Tony Carder. **Vote 8 for 0 against.** (Motion Passed)

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2024-04: AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A PAY-PER-CALL PROGRAM FOR THE GRANT COUNTY RESCUE FIRST RESPONDERS. Ordinance was read to the Quorum Court. Justice Mike Nevens reported that the Budget Committee had looked at cost and recommended passage. With no further discussion, a motion to pass was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Paul Drake. **Vote 8 for 0 against.** (Motion passed)

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2024-05: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2023-14, THE ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS. Treasurer Tim Stuckey explained this is to fund completion of the first phase of the Annex project. With no further discussion a motion to approve was made by Justice Mike Nevens and seconded by Justice Jason Roshto. **Vote 8 for 0 against.** (Motion passed)

SALES TAX: The Sales Tax report was presented to the Quorum Court.

OTHER BUSINESS: Judge Randy Pruitt updated the Court on progress at Cox Creek Bridge replacement. Justice Tony Carder asked about road bids. Judge Randy Pruitt stated that the ad for bids should be in next week's paper.
