BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS:

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2023-14, THE 2024 ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, it comes before this Court that there is a need to make additional appropriations to the 2024 Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, this Court finds that there is a need for an additional appropriation to complete the current remodel plan for the County Annex; and

WHEREAS, this Court finds that an appropriation is needed for the newly established Grant County Rescue pay-per-call program as defined in the Grant County Rescue/SAR pay-per-call policy; and

THEREFORE, the Court hereby amends the 2024 Annual Budget to reflect the following:

Section 1. Budget Amendment.

This amendment to the 2024 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas increases the appropriations for the following expenditures by the amount listed:

- ARPA Revenue Replacement Fund 1006
 - County Annex - Office 121
 - Building Materials & Repairs 1006-0121-2020 \$ 400,000.00
- Grant County Rescue Fund 3400
 - Other Professional Services 3400-0504-3009 \$ 10,000.00
- Emergency Medical 2017 Tax Fund 3407
 - Transfers Out - Office 8888
 - Transfer to Grant County Rescue 3407-8888-9999 \$ 10,000.00

This amendment to the 2024 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas also reduces the 2024 appropriation for the following expenditure by \$400,000.00 and changes it to the following amount:

- ARPA Revenue Replacement Fund 1006
 - Transfers Out - Office 8888
 - Transfer to County General 1006-8888-9999 \$ 220,000.00

Section 2. Purpose. This Ordinance shall constitute new appropriations for the purposes specified for the calendar year 2024 subject only to revision or modification by the Quorum Court.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provision or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. Per Arkansas Code annotated §14-14-907 this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
