WHEREAS, the Arkansas Secretary of State's office has solicited bids for a new voting system to support elections in Arkansas and awarded a contract to Election Systems and Software (ES&S) for a new voting system; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State's Office has purchased equipment from ES&S and allowing Grant County to implement the new equipment on a cost share basis which has been approved by the Quorum Court; and

WHEREAS, the current election equipment in use in Grant County will revert back to the State to be traded in towards the purchase price of the new equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Grant County Election Commission voted on June 12, 2018 to adopt and implement the new voting system as provided by the Secretary of State in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, the Grant County Election Commission voted on June 12, 2018 to utilize in each polling location all parts of the voting system purchased by Secretary of State, including, but not limited to, one or more Express Poll tablets, one or more Express Vote marking devices, one or more DS-200 tabulators, and one or more Express Pass printers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grant County Quorum Court that the Quorum Court chooses to adopt and implement the new voting system in its entirety, as set out above to become effective for the November 6, 2018 General Election.
