

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED;

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING GRANT COUNTY TO BECOME A VOTE CENTER FOR ALL FURTHER ELECTIONS AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS;

Section 1. SOURCE

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated 7-5-101 (e) (1) (B) of the Election Laws of the State of Arkansas, the county may adopt an Ordinance to establish 7 vote centers for the elections

Section 2. SEVERABILITY

If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such validity shall not affect other provisions and sections of the Ordinance, and to such end the provisions and sections of this Ordinance are declared severable.

Section 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE

An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
