BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN  
ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

"AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING GRANT COUNTY TO BECOME A VOTE CENTER FOR ALL FURTHER  
ELECTIONS AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY, REPLACING GRANT COUNTY ORDINANCE 2017-05"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF  
ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated Section 7-5-101(e)(1)(B), the Grant County  
Quorum Court hereby establishes vote centers for elections held in Grant County. The number and  
location of such vote centers will be determined by the Quorum Court based upon funding availability  
and internet connectivity.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance hereby replaces in its entirety Grant County Ordinance 2017-05.

SECTION 3. If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent  
jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and sections of the Ordinance and shall be  
severable.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety,  
an emergency is hereby declared. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its  
passage.
